### Measles

As you would have seen from the letter yesterday we have had a student confirmed with a case of Measles. Unfortunately before being aware the student did attend school for two days whilst infectious. Yesterday on the advice of the Health Department, parents of students from the infected students class as well as their buddy class who are not immunised were asked to collect their child and keep them home for a quarantine period until the 1<sup>st</sup> of November. What we found during this process was that many students on our records listed as unimmunised were able to produce up to date immunisation information showing they were in fact immunised. We would ask if you did not produce an immunisation certificate at the time of enrolment that you arrange to get a copy to the office as soon as possible. If you're unsure email or call to confirm.

Immunisation is a personal choice and we ask the community be respectful and mindful in their conversations around this matter. If you have concerns or questions contact the school rather than other parents the last thing we want is wrongful persecution or misinformation spreading in the playground. We will continue to keep you informed and please be assured if your child's class is directly affected you will be personally notified. For now all students not directly affected can continue to attend school whether immunised or not. Below are some links for more information;

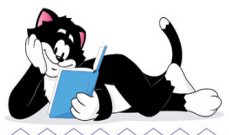
