Teachers will be loading some 'at home' learning ideas to their Seesaw pages in the coming days that you might like to do at home. We hope this full school quarantine will stop the spread of Measles in our school community.

We thank you for your understanding and appreciate your patience with disruptions during this period. Thank you to all the families who have arranged copies of vaccinations records so quickly it has helped us to update our records and ensure we are giving the right information to families.

Due to the quarantine period team and group photos have been postponed until Friday 15th November to assist in having more students present for them.
